## Mobile Dentist is Coming to NV

Your students recently brought home a consent/permission form for the Ohio Dental Outreach "Mobile Dentists". This is a program that brings a state licensed dentist to Northview to check your child's mouth and teeth, as well as provide a cleaning, x-rays as needed, fluoride treatment, and apply sealants as needed. The program includes a dental report card that will be sent home, and may also include additional care and visits if needed. The best part is this service has **no cost to families!** Participation in this is in no way required, but if you choose to have your student participate you will need to complete and return the consent/permission form to school by **November 8, 2017**.
